Scope

All Bornean ethnic groups with a significant population in Sabah and Sarawak are listed. Some of the entries in this list vary from that in the Library of Congress Subject Headings in an effort to create more uniform and accurate entries. The majority of the entries cannot be found in the LCSH.

Many available literature were examined in the preparation of this list. Important works include *Ethnologue* (Summer Institute of Linguistics), *Who's who in Sabah* (Phyllis Dunn, Summer Institute of Linguistics, 198-?) and the important and valuable publications about the peoples of Sabah and Sarawak found in the Sabah Collection of Sabah State Library.

Arrangement

The list is arranged alphabetically and in the same style and format as LCSH. Entry details include the main entry, a see-from reference of all variant names, and any broader or narrower terms.
